- <u>Billingham Beck Saltmarsh South p12 & 13</u>
 Hasn't been recognised previously, saltmarsh on banks of Billingham beck, encapsulated area of saltmarsh plant communities, you can often see seals hauling out there.
- Hartburn Beck p 14 & 15
 South of Stockton between Stockton and the A66. This sire has a population of water voles, which are very well-established and well recorded. The Environment agency and Stockton council have both done improvement work on this site. In addition, a friend's group have taken it on board and done improvement work including adding a series of ponds.
