<b>Summary/short description of bid</b>  <i>Max 100 words</i>	Green Fields Neighbourhood Improvement Association is asking for a grant of £1000 from the TVNP grant panel to build a 5m stretch of boardwalk over a wet grassland on the easterly end of the Green Fields site.
<b>What is the aim of the project?</b>  <i>Max 100 words</i>	With funding, the aim of the project is to build a 5m boardwalk over an area of ground that is currently impassable without wellington boots and completely inaccessible for those in wheelchairs or with accessibility restrictions.
<b>Planned result of the project?</b>  <i>Max 100 words</i>	The boardwalk would make this route accessible to all users, along with the added benefit of making the walk more pleasant for all users. A secondary motive is that, current use is churning up the ground in this area, eroding the footpath and damaging this wetland habitat. Installing a boardwalk would prevent any further damage to this habitat and allow this wetland to restore over time.
