There are **47 nature partnerships** across England and we are the only one to secure funding from the **National Lottery Community Fund** to run our partnership until **the end of 2022**



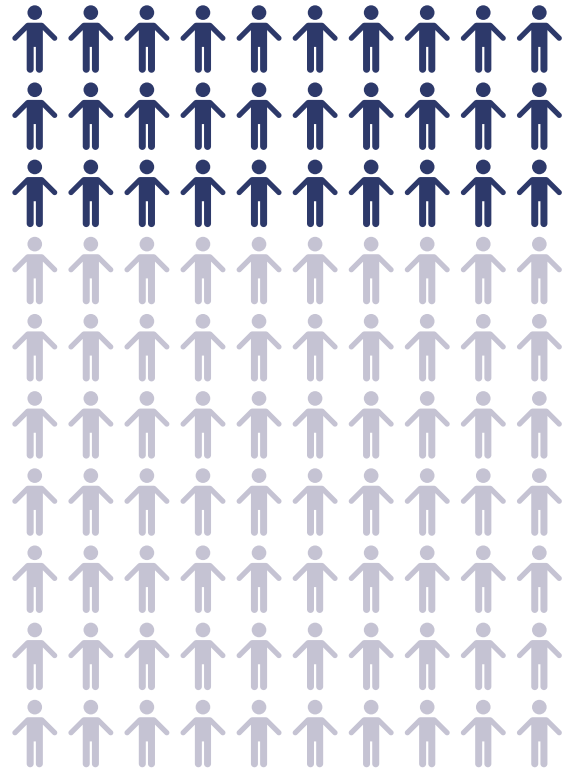
